

# Additional information on the positioning of the Chief

## Executive Officer's remuneration policy

It is recalled, as needed, that the remuneration policy in place within the company, applied in particular to senior executives, aims to position their remuneration between the median and the 3rd quartile.

In order to assess the competitiveness and structure of the remuneration of the executive corporate officer, the following elements of the panel<sup>1</sup> were taken into account:

#### • Target annual fixed and variable remuneration:

- For **2024**, it is positioned slightly below the median of the panel;
- For **2025**, it is positioned slightly below the 3rd quartile of the panel.

#### • Target total annual remuneration:

- For **2024** it is positioned slightly above the 1st quartile of the panel;
- For **2025** it is positioned slightly below the median of the panel.
